



## Cracking Start for Keystone Brewery

Husband and Wife Team Alasdair and Charlotte Large recently hosted a successful Launch Party at their new brewery, The Keystone Brewery at Berwick St Leonard nr. Hindon in Wiltshire. About four hundred people from the local area and as far afield as Yorkshire and Sunderland visited the Brewery to sample the four regular beers;

**Bedrock Bitter** at 3.6 % packed with loads more flavour than its low alcohol volume suggests.

**Large One** at 4.2 % a fantastic rounded Best Bitter.

**Corner stone** at 4.8% the strongest in the group, dark and malty with plenty of punch.

**Gold Standard** at 4% a golden light beer that is set to convert a few lager drinkers and ladies to the delights of real ale drinking, hoppy and citreousy, ideal for the hot weather.

Having sold out of all the first Brews, Alasdair has already upped the volume in his 10 Brewers Barrel plant (About 1600L) to meet demand and will soon be looking at bottling the beer for sale at farmers markets, delis and farm shops.

In keeping with the company ethos of 'local and sustainable', Keystone brewery will soon be surrounded with specifically grown barley near its home on the Fonthill estate. The barley will be malted locally at the Warminster Maltings. With the locally grown barley, water extracted from the chalk aquifers under the Fonthill Estate and English grown hops, Keystone Beer is a truly a low food miles product!

Keystone Beer can always be found at the Royal Oak in Swallowcliffe and in many other local pubs and hostleries. The beer is already a firm favourite at many of this summers beer festivals such as, Southampton, Worcestershire, Bristol, Peterborough and many many more. Look out for us at the Dinton beer festival (26<sup>th</sup>-29<sup>th</sup> August), Tisbury Carnival, Salisbury food and Drink Festival and the Shaftesbury Local Food Festival.
